

2021 MALAYSIA FLOOD SITUATION REPORT AND RECOVERY PLAN

Highlights

Overview of the situation

MERCY Malaysia has been proactively implementing recovery measures following the damage assessment previously conducted to minimise the impact of the flood to the local community.

Activities that were conducted by MERCY Malaysia

Pahang – distributed 190 Food Packs, 190 Hygiene Kits, 125 Dignity Kits and 360 disinfectant items to five locations.

Pahang – distributed 72 well being kits, 32 hand sanitisers, and 240 disinfectant items to BOMBA frontliners in Ringlets and Brinchang, Cameron Highlands. The BOMBA rescuers have been helping the community during the emergency phase.
