## Highlights

### Overview of the situation

Currently, MERCY Malaysia has addressed the confronting issues of the flood victims during the flood disaster. Following this, MERCY Malaysia is now focusing on implementing appropriate responses based on the prior needs assessments to help alleviate the burdens of the affected communities. For instance, school facility support, rebuilding latrines and distribution of household items, all at it's initiation process.

### Activities that were conducted by MERCY Malaysia

Johor – Distributed disinfectant items such as toilet bowl cleaner, refill and Mr. Muscle MNF to:

- Kampung Cahaya Baru.
- Kampung Orang Asli Cahaya Baru.
- Kampung Sepakat, Masai.
